




# D.S. KOTHARI HOSTEL



## Chairs

## ● *Computer Room*

The hostel has a well equipped air-conditioned computer room with five Computers. Webcams have been installed on two computers for additional support. The Screen Reader Software has been installed in the Computer Room for the visually challenged residents. The routers have been installed by the DUCC on all floors of the hostel for internet facility.





## ● *Washing Machine, Geysers and Laundry*



The hostel has 6 Semi automatic washing machines which can be self operated.

The hostel has 6 geysers installed on different floors .

Ironing of clothes and laundry services are available near the hostel gate. The residents can avail these facilities, on payment.





## *Badminton Court*

A badminton court in a hostel is a popular facility for the students looking to stay active, improve their sporting skills, and bond with peers.





## ● *Mess Facility*

The sitting capacity of the dining hall is 50. The air cooled mess provides quality vegetarian and non-vegetarian food with breakfast, lunch and dinner for all bonafide residents. An induction cooking top is also available in the mess. R.O. facility for clean drinking water is available in mess and on all floors.

## ● *Committee Room*

The hostel has a spacious , airconditioned Committee Room with LCD Projection facilities to conduct meetings with the residents and to organise various events.



## ● *Guest Room*

The hostel offers two rooms for comfortable stay of visitor of residents.

(a)The hostel has one Guest room with A.C. and attached washroom, and one 'Exchange Room' without A.C. and shared washroom.

(b)The Guest Room and the 'Exchange Room' can accommodate up to two guests each.

## 24 X 7 Security with CCTV Camera System


- 01 Twenty-six CCTV cameras have been installed around the hostel, covering its entire premises for the security of the residents.

# Demand Ratio of Students





